- ◆ Meetings are held at 10:00 am on the third Monday of every month except July, August, and November. Location: St. Mark Lutheran Church, 117 West Keller Street, Mechanicsburg, PA. Parking is behind the church or on the street, with the entrance in the rear of the building.
- ◆ You may apply at any time. Dues are \$35.00 per year (April - November). On/ after November 1st, dues are \$15.00 (November to April). Please make checks payable to **Penn-Cumberland Garden Club**. Dues include a Member Directory/ Club Yearbook, Club Newsletter, *Keystone Gardener*, and *National Gardener* (online).
- ◆ Every member shall abide by the Club's Bylaws, which include the following membership responsibilities:
