1. Meetings are held at 10:00 AM, the third Monday of the month, September through June. We meet at St. Mark Lutheran Church, 117 West Keller Street, Mechanicsburg, PA. Park behind the church or on the street and enter from the back.
2. You can apply at any time. The cost is \$40 if you join in April - November; or \$20 if you join in December – April. Please make the check payable to: Penn-Cumberland Garden Club. Your dues include membership in National Garden Clubs, Inc., Garden Club Federation of Pennsylvania and publications of the *Keystone Gardener*.
3. Each member shall conform to the Club's Bylaws, which include the following membership responsibilities:
  - a. **You must be willing to serve on at least one committee.**
  - b. **You will be asked to bring refreshments to share at 2 Membership Meetings.**
  - c. **We are a "green" club – bring your own place setting and cloth napkin for lunch.**

Members are strongly encouraged to attend and participate in the Club's annual Holiday Market and Luncheon, held the first Monday after Thanksgiving at the Penn-Harris Hotel, and the Plant Sale in May. The proceeds of both go towards underwriting our scholarships, library donations, grants and multiple civic beautification efforts.
5. To resign, a member shall present their resignation in writing by e-mail or a letter mailed to the Membership Chair or the Corresponding Secretary.
6. Membership dues are collected each year beginning in April so that we can forward some of each members' dues to our national, state and district organizations by the June 15<sup>th</sup> deadline.
